Theater Arts

- Awarded 3 scholarships to Hinsdale South High School graduating Thespians in May 2010. The first place award will be \$1,500, second place \$1,000, and the third place \$500.

Literacy

- The Foundation sponsored its fourth annual “Write-on Literary Festival” during October and November. A poetry writing workshop with Robbie Q. Telfer and an evening with John Green, winner of the Michael L. Printz award for “Looking for Alaska” were held. Additionally, two writing competitions were held, with 1st, 2nd and 3rd place prizes awarded in poetry and short story.

Music

- The Foundation is providing three students with private piano lessons.
- The Foundation is providing 6 students from Eisenhower Jr. High with private instrument lessons through the EJH band program.
- In November 2009, donated 6 instruments to Hermes Elementary School and 6 instruments to Johnson Elementary School, both in Aurora, IL.
- The Instrument Recycling Program continues at PM Music in Aurora, which is the ongoing drop-off site for used instruments at any time during the year.

Environment

- The Foundation sponsored the 2010 Darien Arbor Day celebration. 7 memorial trees were planted at two parks in Darien. Local school groups raised butterflies and released them at the plantings. Students were educated about the importance of trees in the environment.

Grants

- Awarded Actors with Special Needs out of LaGrange Township High School \$1,000 for their upcoming theater productions.
- Awarded Forest Preserve District of DuPage County \$2,500 for their 2010-2011 Mighty Acorns program.
